Adding Measurement Types

By default, the "Vitals" section of the E-Chart's Measurements contains a finite set of measurements. Additional measurements can be added to this list for ease of use. Note that labs received electronically will populate a patient's measurements upon receipt.


Warning: Adding a measurement type to OSCAR that will also be received via lab result will result in duplicate measurements.

I. Adding an Existing Measurement Type

1. Click on Admin. Click on Customize oscarMeasurements.




2. Click Edit Measurement Group.



3. Choose the group to modify. Click Modify Measurement Types.

Note: Click Modify Measurement Style to change the style sheet. The Vitals section uses the sheet measurementTemplateBlue.css.



4. The left-hand column are existing measurement types. The right-hand column are measurements that exist under the group you choose in step 3. Click a measurement in the left-hand column and then click Add.


Note: If the measurement does not appear in the left-hand column, see Section II. Adding a New Measurement Type.

Note: You can remove measurements from the group by selecting it in the right-hand column and clicking Delete.





Note: When the appropriate group is selected under Measurements on a patient's E-Chart, it will appear.




II. Adding a New Measurement Type

- 1. Click on Admin. Click on Customize oscarMeasurements.
- 2. Click Add Measurement Type.



3. Fill in the appropriate fields then click Add.





- (a) **Type**: identifier when adding the measurement type to a group
- (b) **Type Description**: identifier when viewing measurement types
- (c) **Display Name**: will appear on a patient's Measurements
- (d) **Measuring Instruction**: default instruction as seen on patient's Measurements
- (e) Validation: the value measurement input must be in order to be saved

III. Adding a New Measurement Group

- Click on Admin. Click on Customize oscarMeasurements.
- 2. Click Add Measurement Group.



Choose a group name and a style sheet. Click continue.
 Note: Your OSCAR has two style sheets. The Vitals group on the E-Chart uses measurementTemplateBlue.css.



4. Add measurements to be included in this group. See Section 1, Step 4.



5. When measurements are added to the E-Chart, this group will be an option.




IV. Adding Measurement Instructions

- 1. Click on Admin. Click on Customize oscarMeasurements.
- 2. Click Add Measuring Instruction.



3. Choose the Measurement Type, input the new instruction and validation. See Section II. Step 3d-e.



The instruction will now appear when the measurement group is opened from the patient's E-Chart.
